5. You shall report any change in your residential address, telephone number, or employment to O.C.C.S., Inc., or the Court, within seven (7) days.
6. You shall pay all fines, court costs, and the Crime Victims Compensation Fund Judgment in accordance with the time schedule set out in your Fine And Court Costs Memorandum.

7. If you are being supervised by O.C.C.S., Inc., you shall follow all directives given to you by the officer assigned to supervise your case.

____. You shall perform _____ hours of community service through C.O.S.P. in accordance with the schedule established by your probation officer.
